Cook's Corner

This is another cheese ball recipe but with a bit of a twist. Give it a try for your next party.

Pineapple Cheese Ball

Ingredients:

- 2 8-oz. pk. Softened cream cheese
- 10 oz. of shredded extra sharp Cheddar Cheese.
- 1 8 1/2-oz. can crushed pineapple drained
- 1/2 tsp. cayenne pepper (more or less)
- 2 Cups finely chopped nuts.

1. Blend the cream cheese and cheddar till smooth.
2. Add the pineapple and cayenne. The amount of cayenne depends on your taste. Also you could substitute ground chipotle or smoked paprika.
3. Form into one large ball or 2 small balls
4. Roll in the chopped nuts.
5. Refrigerate
